Outsider access and smoking prohibited</li> <li>☐ If you enter a room other than your own, you are also judged as an outsider (Forced move-out if entering other rooms and sleeping from 01:00 to 05:00)</li> <li>☐ Forced move-out if smoking in the residence hall(including e-cigarettes)</li> <li>6. Sleeping Out: Go to Residence Hall Homepage → MyPage → Apply for Sleeping Out</li> <li>☐ Application date: at least one day prior to the start of the night out</li> <li>☐ Inspection can be postponed when applying for a sleeping out before inspection date during the vacation period (No postponement during the semester)</li> <li>☐ If the inspection postponement enters the dormitory during the sleeping out period or does not undergo an re-inspection after the sleeping out period, 3 penalty points will be imposed.</li> </ul>
