

## Notice for Feb. 2025 Inspection

### ■ Plans for Room Inspection

	Category	Candidates	Time	Penalty
<b>Inspection</b>	<b>Regular inspection</b>	All residents	<b>From 8PM to 10PM on Feb. 5(Wed.)</b>	3 penalty points for non-inspection until 1 <sup>st</sup> re-inspection
	<b>1st re-inspection</b>	Unchecked Regular inspection	<b>From 8PM to 10PM on Feb. 9(Sun.)</b>	
	<b>2nd re-inspection</b>	Unchecked 1st Re-inspection	<b>From 9PM to 10PM on Feb. 16(Sun.)</b>	Additional 1penalty point are imposed
<b>Methods</b>	<p>1. <b>Regular inspection, 1st re-inspection:</b> Residents requesting an inspection should open their windows and room doors. The Residential Assistant will inspect rooms with open doors</p> <p>2. <b>2nd re-inspection:</b> To request a 2nd re-inspection, contact your assigned floor staff or use the KakaoTalk channel before the re-inspection period (18:00 to 21:00). The floor staff will then visit and inspect the rooms that have requested this re-inspection</p>			
<b>Information</b>	<p>1. <b>All residents in a room are subject to inspection, not just one person.</b> Failure to complete inspection by the 1st re-inspection will result in 3 penalty points for missing the regular inspection. <b>Additionally, one penalty point will be imposed weekly until the inspection is completed.</b></p> <p>2. Regular inspections during vacation can be postponed if you apply for a sleeping out period that includes both the regular inspection and re-inspection dates. Applications must be made from 25 Dec(Wed)* to 4 Feb(Tue) before the regular inspection date. Sleeping out requests after 5 Feb(Wed) will not be accepted.</p> <p>*Note: If you applied for a sleeping-out before the fall semester's regular check-out date (12/26), you must reapply for the winter session.</p> <p>*If you applied for a sleeping-out before the regular check-out date of the fall semester (12/25), you must apply again for a sleeping-out during the winter session</p> <p>(E.g.1) <b>Application</b> date: 26 Dec, period: 4 Feb to 9 Feb - inspection postponement is <b>possible</b> (subject to re-inspection on 16 Feb)</p> <p>(E.g.2) <b>Application</b> date: 26 Dec, period: 6 Feb to 9 Feb, <b>missed</b> inspection on 5 Feb - <b>3penalty points</b></p> <p>(E.g.3) <b>Application</b> date: 5 Feb, period: 6 Feb to 9 Feb - inspection postponement is <b>not possible</b></p> <p>(E.g.4) Application date: 24 Dec, period: 4 Feb to 9 Feb - inspection postponement is not possible (reapplication for sleeping out is required)</p> <p>If you enter the dormitory during your approved sleeping out period or fail to undergo re-inspection after the sleeping out period, 3 penalty points will be imposed. If you cannot be present for the re-inspection on Sunday due to returning from and then leaving for another sleep out, you must coordinate the inspection schedule in advance.</p> <p>(E.g.1) <b>Initial</b> application period: 5 Feb to 9 Feb, <b>additional</b> application period: 12 Feb to 16 Feb - <b>Re-inspection from 10 Feb to 11 Feb</b></p> <p>(E.g.2) <b>Initial</b> application period: 5 Feb to 9 Feb, <b>additional</b> application period: <b>10 Feb to 16 Feb</b> - Postponement possible (additional application must be made before the initial period ends)</p> <p>3. To contact your building's Residential Assistant, check the bulletin board or the DID next to the elevator on the first floor of your building.</p> <p>4. Please ensure to <b>check</b> both the <b>Basic communication</b> and <b>Information</b>.</p>
